

## **ENERGY EFFICIENCY INCENTIVES**

Equipment	Rebate	Specifications*
Ground Source Heat Pumps	\$700 or \$350/ton 5 ton max	<ul> <li>\$700/ton – residential upgrades from electric resistance heat;</li> <li>\$350/ton – new construction or LP conversion</li> <li>This system must be the structure's primary heat source</li> <li>Non-residential unit rebates subject to Board approval</li> </ul>
Lighting – LED bulbs	\$2 per bulb	<ul> <li>Limited to:</li> <li>4 bulbs per year, per member (residential)</li> <li>20 bulbs per year, per member (business/farm)</li> </ul>
Yardlights (including free installation)	\$100	<ul> <li>50W LED light (approximate retail value: \$280) - \$100 rebate</li> <li>Saves approximately \$36 per year</li> </ul>
Air Source Heat Pumps	\$800 or \$400 per unit	<ul> <li>\$800 – residential upgrades from electric resistance heat</li> <li>\$400 – new construction or LP conversion</li> <li>This system must be the structure's primary heat source</li> </ul>
Central Air Conditioners	\$200 per unit	• 14.5 to 15 SEER - \$200 rebate
Water Heaters – Electric Heat Pump	\$400 per unit	Rebate available for new construction or for upgrades from electric resistance
Energy Star Refrigerator or Freezer	\$50	To receive your rebate, you must dispose of your old, working unit. Provide proof of disposal from your appliance dealer. If your dealer does not dispose of old units, contact FEC.

## **CONSERVATION GRANTS**

Members may apply for a grant to cover 50% of the cost of a permanently installed energy conservation device, up to \$100 per grant. One grant application accepted per member, per year. Eligible energy-saving devices include – but are not limited to – the following:

- Clothes line
   Corn, pellet or wood stove
   Trees for shading (site plan required)
  - Insulation
     Programmable thermostat
     Occupancy sensor
    - Tractor heater timer Insulated earth tube waterer

Note: A maximum of \$2000 per year will be awarded in this category.

## \*CONDITIONS

- Rebates and grants are available to FEC members only.
- Rebate or grant must not exceed total invoiced amount.
- All units must be new (receipt for purchase must be dated within the past six months) and permanently installed on member premises.
- Members are responsible for contractor scheduling and associated installation costs.
- Members may be responsible for costs associated with upgrades to Cooperative systems due to increased capacity requirements.
- Rebates are based on residential square footage requirements for heat loss and gain. (No unit over-sizing funded.)
- Warranties, liabilities and insurance shall be the responsibility of the member.
- Rebate and grant applications are subject to Board approval.
- Additional Cooperative incentives may be available but not listed here.
