SOLAR GARDEN

The FEC Community Solar Garden is approaching six years of generating clean, local power for co-op members! There are now 296 modules owned by 125 members. The solar garden's increased power production has kept FEC's summer peak demand down and electric rates steady. Adding local power to the grid keeps a portion of your monthly payment in the community.

FEC continues its commitment to generating local power and is again expanding the solar garden. Take advantage of this *reliable and affordable* way to invest in solar.

FIRST-TIME BUYERS! \$375 for your first module

Additional modules (up to a total of 10) may be purchased for \$470 each.

Members who currently own one or more modules in the Solar Garden may purchase up to 10 additional modules at \$470.

This is a first-come, first-served offer. FEC will provide the mounts, transformers, insurance and labor. **You purchase the modules; FEC does the rest.**

As soon as your module begins generating electricity, FEC will collect the power, put it on the grid and credit your monthly bill for the retail value of the power (\$0.125/kWh). This rate will rise as retail rates rise. Your name-brand module will generate power for at least 30-40 years.

- Average monthly credit per module (approximate): \$3.50 - \$4.00
- Individual ownership of solar generation will be limited to monthly kWh energy use.
- Member owns actual module(s). Modules can be resold to FEC at a depreciated rate if member moves out of FEC service area.
